For some, this might be your first experience, while for others it's an annual event spanning decades AND generations. Either way, you're all now part of a 77-years long tradition; enjoying a parade put on by the citizens, for the citizens.

We are proud and thankful to be honored by a flyover from the **122nd Fighter Wing**, "Blacksnakes" out of the Fort Wayne Air National Guard Base. It began with our application to the Federal Aviation Administration,



(FAA), back in January, culminating with two **A-10 Thunderbolt II** - **"Warthog"** aircraft making a single pass, at approximately 10:10 a.m. Their mission today: make parade flyover passes for eight similar events.

The **122nd Fighter Wing** traces its heritage back to the **358th** Fighter Group that was activated in **January**, **1943**, at Richmond Army Air Base, VA. The **358th** flew interdiction and bomber escort missions from England until D-Day. In May **1946**, the group was re-designated as the 122nd Fighter Group, assigned to the Indiana Air National Guard. During the WWII the **358th**, was awarded three Distinguished Unit Citations. Portions of the Wing were activated during the Korean War, and the Berlin Crisis. After

September 11, 2001, they were one of the first American units deployed overseas. The 122nd Fighter Wing continues to operate a full squadron of A-10 Thunderbolt II aircraft.







City of LaPorte Proclaimed Capital for the Day

Since the mid-1940's the City of LaPorte been recognized for its 4th of July Celebration excellence. This year is the 77th consecutive year, in which, the sitting Governor of the State of Indiana has seen fit to name LaPorte Capital for the Day. From its citizenry which lines the two miles long parade route, to the community fireworks and local celebrations, LaPorte continues to rise above the rest.

As written in the Proclamation:

Whereas, July 4th is a day set aside for celebration and renewed dedication to the principles of our priceless American heritage; and Whereas, the mantle of responsibility for the continuation of our free nation rests on the shoulders of every American citizen: and

Whereas, the Kiwanis Club of LaPorte sees to encourage the recognition and respect for the traditions and principles of our American Heritage.. Now, Therefore, I, Eric Holcomb, Governor of the Sate of Indiana, do hereby proclaim LaPorte As Capital For the Day.



Parade Grand Marshal – The New York Blower Company Will Mathis – Board Member/Founder's Descendent There are many companies which are well suited for this year's parade theme: Made in America – With Home Town Pride. The New York Blower Company, however, epitomizes that theme, as its reach is from coast to coast, and around the globe.

New York Blower Company started as Mathis Brothers Company in Chicago, in 1889. And in 1904 purchased The

New York Blower Company, with its factory being in Bucyrus, OH. When JW Mathis saw an opportunity to move back closer to Chicago, in 1917, he purchased the buildings and property of American 3-Way Prism Company in the industrial community of LaPorte, IN, pop. 15,000. In 1919, operations were fully moved from Bucyrus to LaPorte, and by October of that year, the factory was operational with a work force of over 100.



The company has successfully continued operations for 104 years, enduring World Wars, the Great Depression, and a global pandemic. It has participated

in ventilation projects, such as the Merchandise Mart, the largest building in the world, until the Pentagon was constructed. And has supplied 680 centrifugal fans housed in the Pentagon, since its construction in the early 1940's. New York Blower fans were also used at Ford Bomber, Bendix Aviation, General Motors and the US Navy during the World War II effort. Generations of LaPorteans have appreciated the home town expertise of New York Blower, as NYB fans have been running in LaPorte's own Civic Auditorium since 1929.







Parade Honorary Grand Marshal - Craig M. Dwight

"Distinguished by his humanity in living, his loyalty in friendship, his wisdom in council, and his inspiration in leadership." these are just some of the words bestowed upon Craig M Dwight, as a 2023 recipient of the Sagamore of the Wabash award – one of the highest honors awarded by the State of Indiana. From Management Trainee to Chairman of the Board, the past 44 years encompassed notable career success and selfless community service.

A 1979 graduate of Indiana Univ., Blooming, IN. Craig began and ended his career at Horizon Bank, with a brief tenure with First of America Bank, in Holland, Michigan. Under his leadership Horizon Bank grew from a \$400 million bank, to a bank with over \$7.8 billion. Along the way, Craig shared his leadership skills and passions throughout the community.

Craig has served and chaired the local hospital board, United Way of La Porte County, and the local economic development corporation, as well as serving

in leadership positions, for numerous other community organizations including The MC Chamber of Commerce, St. Paul School Foundation, the Michigan City Economic Development Commission, Purdue North Central Advisory Board, the Chicago Federal Reserve Bank's Community Financial Institutions Counsel, and the Indiana Bankers Assoc. Board. Craig was honored to ring the opening bell for the NASDAQ in New York City in 2019.



Senior Abby Robakowski had 23 of those home runs (setting an all-time Indiana single season homerun record) The Cougars were led in the pitching circle by first team all-state player, Ava Geyer. Geyer finished the season with 300 strikeouts and an earned run average of 0.99.




