#### Governor Eric J. Holcomb

Eric J. Holcomb, 51st Governor of the State of Indiana, is a lifelong Hoosier who was born in Indianapolis, Indiana, graduated from Pike High School in Indianapolis and Hanover College in southeastern Indiana. He went on to serve six years in the U.S. Navy, first at Naval Station Great Lakes and later in Florida and Portugal. Holcomb is currently serving in his second term as governor having been elected in 2016 and 2020 when he received the most votes for governor in Indiana History. Prior to his election as governor. Holcomb served as

Indiana's 51st Lieutenant Governor. A basketball fan and collector of presidential signatures, Holcomb has not only made a basket in each of Indiana's 92 counties but also possesses documents signed by every U.S. president.

Governor Holcomb joins the Kiwanis Club of La Porte in welcoming everyone to La Porte and also to the great state of Indiana. This year he joins past generations of governors in the long tradition of proclaiming La Porte "Capital for the Day" and celebrates the holiday with us all as Grand Celebration Marshal.

Holcomb serves on the Executive Committee of the National Governors Association and Republican Governors Association. In 2018, *The Hill* named him one of ten governors shaping the future of politics. Holcomb and his wife, Janet, live with their cat, Topper, in the Governor's Residence in Indianapolis. This year marks his 8th year as Governor of Indiana.

#### CITY OF LA PORTE IS CAPITAL FOR THE DAY



Since the mid-1940's the City of LaPorte has been recognized for its 4th of July Celebration excellence. This year is the 78th in which the sitting Governor of the State of Indiana has seen fit to name the City of La Porte, "Capital for the Day". From its citizenry which lines the two miles long parade route, to the community fireworks and local celebrations, La Porte continues to rise above the rest.

**Whereas**, the mantle of responsibility for the continuation of our free nation rests on the shoulders of every American citizen: and

Whereas, the Kiwanis Club of La Porte seeks to encourage the recognition and respect for the traditions and principles of our American Heritage ... Now, Therefore, I, Eric Holcomb, Governor of the State of Indiana, do hereby proclaim La Porte As Capital For the Day.

#### Father Dennis Blaney

On March 20, 2024, at the age of 92, Father Dennis Blaney was presented with the state of Indiana's highest civilian honor, the Sagamore of the Wabash. It quickly becomes apparent when you learn about Father Blaney that his life of service and impact emerges authentically from his faith, vision, and passion. Sharing Meadows, which opened in 1994, is the brainchild of Father Blaney, allowing other-abled adult residents to recognize and fully develop their God-given talents. It was Father Blaney's early appreciation and heart for other-abled adults that led to this residential community now residing on nearly 200 acres in Rolling Prairie, Indiana.

Sharing Meadows is a residential community that is made up of 5 villages, each includes 3 homes to accommodate 2 villagers and one steward. A 6th village is currently under construction. Beyond the 30 full-time residents that live onsite, a community center added in 2017 expands its impact. For example, Sharing Meadows hosts "Camp Sharing Meadows" each summer to serve hundreds of other-abled adults for a week of fun, learning, and the opportunity to foster lifelong friendships. It's noteworthy that Father Blaney remains active fishing, helping with chores, and engaging in social activities with the villagers. His legacy is founded on a long history of serving the unhoused, the homeless, and finding solutions to community needs everywhere he serves. We are honored to celebrate him today!


#### Maria Fruth

In April of this year, Maria Fruth retired from a career that impacted our La Porte County area through health care for nearly 30 years. From 1996 to 2016, she spent 18 years of her tenure with La Porte Hospital as the CEO of its foundation and served as vice president of the hospital. In 2016, the sale of the La Porte Hospital led to the the creation of the Health Foundation of La Porte (HFL), a private, independent foundation dedicated to empowering La Porte County residents to live healthy and well.

Over the last eight years as HFL's first CEO, Maria led the process of creating what would become the foundation's structure and priorities,

including its strategic direction, grantmaking program, nonprofit capacity-building efforts, and the recruitment of an outstanding staff. She has always excelled in bringing together partners to solve complex problems. In 2021 she opened the doors to the newly constructed 13,000 square foot HFL Conference and Learning Center that houses HFL and also provides area nonprofits with great space and technology for meetings. HFL has invested \$41,4 million in the community thus far. Following early years of teaching alongside community and business experience, Maria Fruth's legacy is found in her longstanding commitment to our community and the individual residents whose health she has championed through funding, collaboration, and accessibility. Maria and her husband, Greg, have resided in La Porte since 1976 and enjoy their three sons and four grandchildren. Join us in celebrating Maria Fruth today!





### GRAND PARADE MARSHAL *John Hancock*

John Hancock is a stage and film director, producer and writer who grew up between the suburbs of Chicago and a fruit farm near LaPorte, Indiana. His early interest was music. As an adolescent, he was an accomplished violinist, and concertmaster of the Chicago Youth Orchestra. He became interested in the theatre while attending Harvard College.

Among many career experiences and highlights, Hancock received a grant from the American Film Institute and directed a short film, suggested by, and co-authored with John Lahr, called Sticky My Fingers ... Fleet My Feet, for which they received an Academy Award nomination. His feature film

credits include *Bang the Drum Slowly*, with Robert De Niro (Paramount), *California Dreaming* (AIP), *Let's Scare Jessica to Death* (Paramount), *Baby Blue Marine* (Columbia), *Weeds* (DEG), and the local favorite and Christmas classic, *Prancer* (Orion), starring Sam Elliot, Cloris Leachman, Abe Vigoda and Rebecca Harrell (shot on his family's fruit farm in LaPorte County, Indiana). *Prancer* celebrates its 35th anniversary this December, and plans are in the works to mark the occasion.

Hancock's *The Looking Glass* (2013) and *The Girls of Summer* (2018) were filmed in Indiana too. In *The Looking Glass*, Hancock says he "tried to catch the sense of returning to this place where you grew up, and falling in love with what you were not truly able to see before." Today we celebrate John Hancock and his ability to portray on film the very feelings we associate with our 2024 parade theme, *Hoosiers - Calling You Home!*

#### Iconic Hoosier's Bus Visits La Porte for the 4th

It's a 1939 Chevy 1.5 ton truck, made into a school bus with a Wayne body (out of Richmond, Indiana). This old charmer is owned by Darvll Baker from Greenfield, Indiana. The bus was originally a school bus in Lebanon and Indianapolis from 1939 until 1949. Once it was retired in 1949, Darryll's grandfather, Jack Baker of New Ross, bought the bus, put the Wavne body on it, and used it as a camper and cargo bus for the Baker family from 1949-1985. It had a couch, bed, stove and icebox in it for many long trips out west and, according to Jack, had visited 39 states.

Daryll said that his family was the Beverly Hillbillies running around the country in the bus. Later, it was used by the movie "Hoosiers" in 1985 as the team bus, and they put in the current seats. The bus has been used in a wide variety of parades, car shows, sporting events, charity events, fairs, etc. since 1986, including many in Washington DC, such as the Cherry Blossom Festival Parade, the Memorial Day Parade, and St. Patty's Day Parade, all on

Constitution Avenue in DC. It was used in 2015-16 by the Indiana Pacers for their "Hickory Pacers" promotions and has been in the 2016 & 2023 Indv 500 Parades. The bus was featured at the NBA All-Star Crossover event, the Horizon League Championships at the State Fair Coliseum, the NIT finals at Hinkle Fieldhouse, the 70 year celebration of Milan's victory both in Milan and a special session in Cincinnati between the Bengals and Reds stadiums. Daryll partners with the Hoosier Gym, the home gym from the movie "Hoosiers" in Knightstown where the bus is often on exhibit. "Calling You Home" to La Porte has been an honor!




