## **Retired Master Sergeant Charles Martin**



June 14th marked the 250<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Continental Army's establishment by the Second Continental Congress in 1775, more than a year before the Declaration of Independence was signed on July 4, 1776. The Kiwanis Club of La Porte selected Mr. Charles Martin as a local veteran to represent the Army's anniversary. What a find in retired Master Sergeant Charles Martin! Mr. Martin was born in La Porte County (Wanatah) in 1934, and he enlisted in the Army in 1954, retiring in 1975. Four of his five brothers also served in the Army. Married to his wife, Mary, for 39 years before she passed, he served two tours in Korea (where he arranged for the adoption of their youngest daughter), one tour each in Ethiopia, France, and Vietnam, plus a temporary duty in South Wales. He returned to our community and worked for another 22 years at Howmet as he and Mary raised their two daughters. Mr. Martin remains extremely active at the age of 91.

Our community is fortunate to benefit from Mr. Martin's continued service at the VFW Post 1130, Post 83 American Legion Honor Guard, AMVETS (Secretary), Vietnam Veterans (Secretary), American Legion Post 403 (Service Officer), Life Member of the Disabled American Veterans, Life Member of the VFW, and membership in the 40 & 8 (an honor society of military veterans). A full life of service worthy of recognition and gratitude brings us together to honor Mr. Charles Martin for his example, commitment, and a lifetime of service.

## U.S. Army's 250th Birthday Celebration



As a matter of history, the Army was established in June, 1775, the Navy in October, 1775, and the Marines in November, 1775. This year marks the 250th anniversary of all 3 branches of the Armed Forces. Much later, President Truman established the Air Force in September 1947 once we had planes! The National Guard actually celebrates its origin from December 1636, when the first militia regiments in North America were organized in Massachusetts.

We thank all our military veterans from each branch of service as we celebrate and appreciate their commitment and sacrifice on behalf of their country and their fellow citizens.

## La Porte Park & Recreation Plans Teen Bash with Kiwanis Club Support

One age group in our community underserved by parks – teens – actually stands to benefit the most from being outdoors in social and recreational activities. Providing spaces and events for teens promotes mental and physical wellness, develops social skills and encourages new experiences.

With that in mind, the Kiwanis Club of La Porte and the City of La Porte Park and Recreation Department are collaborating on a teen initiative this summer. After meeting with students from La Porte High School's Key Club (a student service club sponsored by Kiwanis), the teens have planned a Teen Bash – designed by teens, for teens – on **Saturday, August 9th**, at Fox Park. Planned activities include:

- Painting trash and recycling cans (leaving a legacy)
- Hosting a craft area (morse code bracelets, t-shirt decorating)
   Skatepark showcase or contest

• DJ entertainment and food trucks

• 3-on-3 basketball tournament

• Scavenger hunt with interactive stations

This event not only aligns with the Park Department's mission to engage the youth but also strengthens community ties and showcases the positive impact of collaborative efforts. The hope is the Teen Bash will be a memorable experience for all participants and set a precedent for future community events. Kiwanis Club, beyond supporting the Key Club efforts, has provided a \$4,000 contribution to cover the event expenses. The Kiwanis Club vision is one of being a positive influence in communities worldwide – so that one day, all children will wake up in communities that believe in them, nurture them and provide the support they need to thrive.

Since the mid-1940s, the City of La Porte has been recognized for its excellence in 4th of July celebrations. This year is the 79th in which the sitting Governor of the State of Indiana has seen fit to name the City of La Porte, "Capital for the Day". Thanks to its citizenry, which lines the two-mile-long parade route, La Porte continues to rise above the rest. As written in the Proclamation:

- Whereas, July 4th is a day set aside for celebration and renewed dedication to American Freedom; and
- Whereas, the mantle of responsibility for the continuation of our free nation rests on the shoulders of every American citizen; and
- Whereas, our nation will remain strong only through continued vigilance, education, and commitment to the preservation of liberty and justice, for all; and
- Whereas, the Kiwanis Club of La Porte seeks to encourage such recognition and respect for the traditions and principles of our American heritage by sponsoring an annual celebration of our national Declaration of Independence: "Community Spirit in Full Bloom."

**Now, therefore, I, Mike Braun**, Governor of the State of Indiana, do hereby proclaim July 4<sup>th</sup>, 2025, as **City of La Porte Capital for the Day**...

## La Porte County Family YMCA Launches Mobile Youth Unit in Collaboration with Kiwanis Club of La Porte

The La Porte County Family YMCA and the Kiwanis Club of La Porte are thrilled to announce an exciting new initiative designed to expand youth outreach and eliminate barriers to participation: the **Mobile Youth Unit.** Bolstered by Kiwanis' awarding the idea as their winner for an innovative "Spark Starter" project in late 2024, their \$25,000 contribution, and additional community partnerships, the YMCA is launching a fully equipped 22-foot vehicle that will function as a mobile hub for youth programming. This collaborative outreach project is rooted in a shared mission—to support youth development,



promote equity, and make a lasting impact throughout the La Porte community. The Mobile Youth Unit will travel to underserved neighborhoods and community events, bringing a wide range of engaging, free programs right to the heart of where kids live and play. By removing transportation and cost obstacles, the unit makes it easier for families to access valuable resources and enrichment opportunities.

#### What the Mobile Youth Unit Offers:

- Sports programming to encourage active play and teamwork
- STEAM (science, technology, engineering, arts, and mathematics) inspired activities
- Healthy snacks to support growing minds and bodies

This mobile initiative embodies the YMCA and Kiwanis Club's shared commitment to youth development, equity, and community impact. By meetings kids where they are, we hope to make lasting connections, spark curiosity, and support their growth in fun and meaningful ways. Together, the YMCA and Kiwanis Club of La Porte are paving the way for a more connected, equitable, and empowered future for our community's youth.




